



BYLAWS OF

ILLINOIS INDIANS

a state club affiliated with the

WINNEBAGO INTERNATIONAL TRAVELERS (WIT)

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this organization is the Illinois Indians Club (“Club”) of Winnebago International Travelers (WIT) in the state of Illinois.

ARTICLE II – COLORS AND SYMBOLS

The Club colors are red and black, with the possible use of white. The Club symbol is the image of the American Indian superimposed on the shape of the state of Illinois.

ARTICLE III – CLUB ADMINISTRATION

The Club and these bylaws exist and draw their authority from the bylaws of WIT. The Club is administered according to the provisions of those WIT bylaws. The following provisions are supplementary to or in definition of the WIT bylaws and should there be any conflict now or in the future, the WIT bylaws rule.

Section 1: Membership in the Club is open to any person or family while a member in good standing of WIT.

Section 2: Each person listed on the current membership card is entitled to one vote.

Section 3: REGULAR MEETINGS for each year are scheduled by the Executive Board and announced at the previous year’s Fall meeting. SPECIAL MEETINGS may be called by the Club President or by ten percent of the regular membership by notification to all members at least thirty days in advance with notification containing the names of all members so petitioning.

Section 4: Twenty percent of the voting membership shall constitute a quorum.

Section 5: Annual dues per RV are set by the Executive Board and are payable by December 31st for the following twelve month period. Should a member's WIT membership be cancelled for any reason, dues paid to the Club are not refundable.

Section 6: The election of Club officers will be conducted at the Fall meeting each year. The term of office will extend until the following year's Fall meeting.

Section 7: When Club outings are attended by the Executive Director or Regional Directors of WT or their designated substitutes, such attendees will pay rally fee.

ARTICLE IV – BYLAWS

These bylaws may be amended at any regular meeting of the Club by a majority of the members present and voting, provided that a quorum is present and provided that the proposed changes have been submitted to the entire current membership in writing at least thirty days in advance of that meeting.
